

TECHNICON 23

WHITE ELEPHANT AUCTION



Rules:

1. Participants (Sellers *and* Bidders) must be members of Technicon 23, with a registered membership badge. Your Badge Number is also your Bidder Number.
2. Technicon charges a 10% processing fee on sales made through the auction. Seller's final payment will reflect this.
3. Lots are limited to five (5) per convention attendee, 101 total for the auction (the 101st item is Fan Guest of Honor for Technicon 24). No lots after the 100th will be accepted. Lot numbers are being limited to keep the auction fun, and to let us get out at a reasonable hour.
4. Within reason, lots may contain as many items as the seller wishes.
5. Lots should be clearly grouped in a box or bag, and labeled with your name, badge number, and lot number (i.e.- Iim Kirk, badge 1701, lot 2 of 3).
6. Be sure all your information on your "Seller Sheet" (page two of this document) is *printed* clearly, especially the "**make check payable to:**" field. We want you to be able to get your money and spend it as quickly and easily as possible.
Note: if you are viewing this document as a PDF, you can fill in your fields on the computer and print it out.
7. Please turn in your Seller Sheet (and *only* your Seller Sheet) to Registration no later than 6:00 p.m. Saturday. Sheets turned in after that time on Saturday, or on Sunday morning may be refused at the discretion of the auction staff.
8. Actual lots (your stuff) will be accepted between 10:30 a.m. and the start of the auction on Sunday. Lots will not be accepted before 10:30 a.m. Sunday, or after the start of the auction.
9. Lots may be refused at the discretion of the Auction or other Senior Con Staff, based on questionable legal pedigree (illegal stuff).
10. Minimum bid is \$1.00 for all items except Fan Guest of Honor, no exceptions. If you have an item you aren't willing to take a chance on only making a dollar on, please don't put it in the auction. (Minimum bid for Fan Guest of Honor is \$150.00- the price of a Supporting Membership.)
11. Lots which do not sell well be available to be picked up by the seller at the end of the auction. Any lots not picked up by the consignee by the close of the convention will be assumed to have been contributed to Technicon, and will be processed accordingly.
